POLICY: PRIORITY FOR ENTRANCE TO CLASSES

KINDERGARTEN (Registrants to be 5 years of age by 9/1/10)*

- Families with children presently attending St. John Fisher School
- Parishioners' first entry to St. John Fisher School
- Catholic families outside of St. John Fisher Parish
- Families of other faiths

FIRST GRADE (Registrants to be 6 years of age by 9/1/10)*

- Families enrolling a child from St. John Fisher Kindergarten
- Families with children presently attending St. John Fisher School
- Parishioners' first entry to St. John Fisher School
- Catholic families outside of St. John Fisher Parish
- Families of other faiths

GRADES 2-8**

- Current students
- Waiting list students who are siblings of current students or parishioners
- Families with children presently attending St. John Fisher School
- Parishioners' first entry to St. John Fisher School
- Catholic families outside of St. John Fisher Parish
- Families of other faiths

Note: This policy is in effect throughout the formal Open Enrollment Period
(January 4, 2010 through January 29, 2010)

* "Readiness Interviews" are conducted with the teacher for all registrants in Kindergarten and first grade who will be new to the school in 2010-2011 (including siblings of current students). Acceptance of these students is on a "conditional" basis until the interview has been conducted and an official confirmation given.

** "Formal Interviews" are conducted with the principal for all registrants in grades 1-8 who will be new to the school in 2010-2011 (including siblings of current students). Acceptance of these students is on a "conditional" basis until the interview has been conducted, academic and behavioral records reviewed, and an official confirmation given.
