GUIDELINES

The Class Ownership Project does not mean that the parents of the assigned classes are the exclusive volunteers for that event. Instead, fundraising and event success is dependent on ALL FAMILIES being involved, not just those families in the assigned classes.

The assigned classes will be responsible for filling those volunteer positions that are vacant after Family Volunteer Hours (FVH) forms have been completed in the spring.

Room parents will communicate volunteer positions that have not been filled to parents in the assigned classes and ask for their participation. Parents in the assigned classes then sign up for the positions by contacting the Volunteer Coordinator for that event.
